(Note)

1. Fees are subject to change upon and after enrolment.
2. Government-sponsored foreign students are exempt from the examination fees, admission fee and tuition.

Eligibility for Application

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

1. Individuals who have graduated or who will graduate from a Japanese four-year university by September 2020.
2. Individuals who have earned or who will earn a Bachelor's degree from the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education in Japan by September 2020.
3. Individuals who have graduated from a university outside Japan that implements a 16-year school curriculum and have earned a Bachelor's degree, or students who will finish or complete their degree by September 2020.
4. Individuals who have been recognized by the Japanese Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
5. Individuals who are 22 years of age or older by September 2020, and whose qualification is recognized equivalent to a Bachelor's degree by the *Eligibility Screening conducted by University of Tsukuba.
6. Others

*University of Tsukuba conducts eligibility screening to assess whether applicants have academic ability equivalent or superior to that of a graduate from a Japanese four-year university.

Applicants who do not meet any of the criteria 1-4 will need to contact TIAS Admission Office by Monday, 23 December 2019, 5:00 pm (JST) by email (tias-admin@un.tsukuba.ac.jp). Necessary documents will be sent to applicants who are required to undergo eligibility screening.
